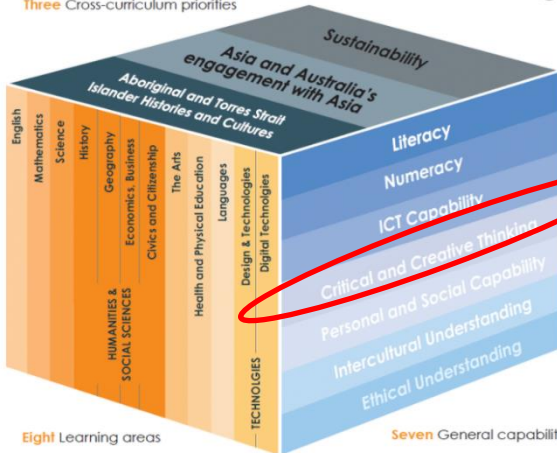

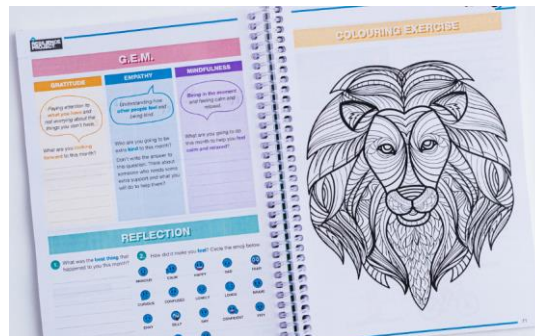

### OneSchool – How to enter subjects electronically

Student information:

Open OneSchool, either through the link on SharePoint or <https://oslp.eq.edu.au/>

**Step 1:** Click on **My Education Plan**

**Step 2:** Click on **Subject Selection** tab

**Step 3:** Click on the blue hyperlinked word "here"

**Step 4:** Choose the available **Subject Selection Model**

**Step 5:** Click on the red pencil **Edit** to select your subjects

**Step 6:** Read the instructions carefully

**Step 7:** Follow the instructions and choose your preferred subjects

**Step 8:** Once finished, scroll down and click on **Save**

Year 9 Subject Information

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Subject	<b>Design Technology</b> <b>Food and fibre production</b>
<b>Subject Description</b>	Year 9 students will complete a semester long course covering Horticulture and Agriculture. Under a "Paddock to Plate" course, students will study a combination of horticultural and animal sciences with an element of agribusiness included. Students will be learning the fundamentals of running their own business by growing and propagating various plants and animals for market. This course is of a mainly practical nature which covers business concepts as well as plant and animal sciences. There will be hands on experience with animals and various tools in a farm environment.
<b>Assessment</b>	Assessment Instruments could include: Portfolios, assignments, theory exams, oral presentations, practical projects
<b>Next Subject</b>	Year 10 Rural Operations Preparation Home learning is given when required.
<b>Home Learning</b>	Students are encouraged and expected to see the teacher for individual assistance if they have trouble with their home learning. If home learning is unable to be completed due to unforeseen circumstances a signed and dated note should be sent to the teacher.

Subject	<b>Design Technology</b> <b>Food Specialisation</b>
<b>Subject Description</b>	Home economics provides a balance between theoretical understandings and practical skills in food studies, textile studies and living environments. The course is intended to develop students' abilities to communicate, manage resources and design and create solutions to practical problems. Students are required to participate in all practical lessons and are responsible for providing and organising their ingredients and textile materials. The areas of study may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Basic Cookery</li> <li>• Nutrition through the life cycle</li> <li>• Main Meals</li> <li>• Smart Choices</li> <li>• Patchwork</li> <li>• Textile Embellishments and Designs</li> <li>• Introduction to Sewing</li> <li>• Upcycling</li> <li>• Hospitality</li> </ul>
<b>Assessment</b>	Assessment Instruments could include: Portfolios, assignments, theory exams, oral presentations, practical projects
<b>Next Subject</b>	Preparation for Hospitality practices, Preparation for Food and Nutrition Home learning is given when required.
<b>Home Learning</b>	Students are encouraged and expected to see the teacher for individual assistance if they have trouble with their home learning. If home learning is unable to be completed due to unforeseen circumstances a signed and dated note should be sent to the teacher.



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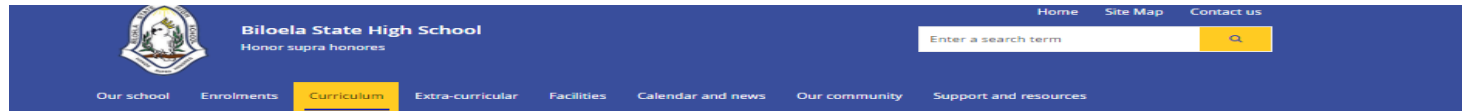
