This funding will be used to:

- 85% of students achieving above NMS in Years 7 and 9 NAPLAN Writing.
- 15% of students achieving in the U2B in Year 7 NAPLAN Writing.
- 10% of students achieving in the U2B in Year 9 NAPLAN Writing.
- 500 MSS in Year 7 NAPLAN Writing.
- 520 MSS in Year 9 NAPLAN Writing.
- 85% of students achieving an A-C result in English, Maths, Science and Humanities in Years 7-10.
- 40% of students achieving an A-B result English, Maths, Science and Humanities in Years 7-10.
- 100% of eligible students achieving a QCE in Year 12.
- 100% of eligible students achieving an OP of 1 to 15 in Year 12.

Our initiatives include:

- improving teacher capacity through targeted professional development in explicit instruction, writing and essential skills for classroom management
- developing a whole school approach to the teaching and learning of writing
- improving student outcomes in writing through targeted teaching and learning
- improving teacher capacity through coaching
- improving support services provided to all students
- implementing short and long-term data cycles to analyse student progress and inform teaching and learning.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

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| • investing in targeted professional development to build school leaders' and teachers' capacity in effectively implementing explicit instruction, writing and essential skills for classroom management | \$40 000 |
| • investing in a Head of Department (Teaching and Learning) to lead the implementation of coaching across the school and additional teaching time to facilitate coaching to build school leaders and teachers capacity and develop reflective practices for improvement | \$200 000 |
| • investing in a Youth Support Coordinator, Community Education Counsellor and Industry Liaison Officer to support all students in developing and engaging in appropriate pathways | \$52 904. |
