Biloela State High School will receive

**\$247,541\***

## This funding will be used to

- Ensure that 85% of students achieving a A-C result in all curriculum areas in Years Seven to Ten. (Sem 2 2021 = 83.2%)
- Ensure that 40% of students achieving a A-B result in all curriculum areas in Years Seven to Ten. (Sem 2 2021 = 43.5%)
- Ensure that 100% of eligible students are achieving a QCE in Year Twelve.
- Ensure that 100% of eligible students are achieving a QCIA.
- Improve attendance in targeted ( Indigenous, Kids-in-Care, vulnerable) student groups.
- Increase the use of expert teaching teams to collaborate and develop skill sets across the school, including Visible Learning
