Under this agreement for 2020 Biloela State High School will receive

\$261,817

This funding will be used to

- Ensure that 85% of students achieving above National Minimum Standards (NMS) in years seven and nine for writing.
- Ensure that 15% of students achieving in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) in year seven for writing.
- Ensure that 10% of students achieving in the U2B in year nine for writing.
- Ensure that 85% of students achieving a A-C result in English, Maths and Science in years seven to ten.
- Ensure that 40% of students achieving a A-B result English, Maths and Science in years seven to ten.
- Ensure that 100% of eligible students achieving a QCE in year twelve.
- Ensure that 100% of eligible students achieving an OP of 1 to 15 in year twelve.
- Improve student access to digital teaching and learning resources.

Our school will improve outcomes by


- Improving school leader and teacher capacity through targeted professional development in:
 - coaching
 - explicit instruction
 - visible teaching and learning
 - writing
 - essential skills for classroom management
 - case management of students
- Improving leading and teaching quality through the implementation of a whole school approach to collegial coaching and feedback.
- Improving student outcomes in writing through the implementation of a whole school approach to the teaching and learning of writing.
- Improving student outcomes through the implementation of a whole school approach to short- and long-term data cycles to analyse student progress inform teaching and learning and case manage students at risk.
- Improving student outcomes through the provision of support services and digital learning.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Investing in targeted professional development to build school leaders and teacher capacity ~ \$26 817.
- Investing in additional teacher aide time to provide targeted support and intervention for identified students ~ \$100 000.
- Investing in a Youth Support Coordinator to support all students in engaging in education and to provide additional support as required ~ \$40 000.
- Investing in an Industry Liason Officer to support all students in developing and engaging in appropriate pathways ~ \$75 000.
- Investing in broadband resources to support digital learning for all students~ \$20 000.
